Direct Support Professionals (DSPs) play a vital role enriching lives and strengthening communities. DSPs are on the front lines of caregiving—and the lifeline that extends far beyond, empowering individuals with disabilities to live independently, achieve goals, and engage meaningfully in daily life.

The Community Connections program of Seven Hills is profoundly grateful for the companionship component DSPs provide in their role as caregivers. Supporting primarily people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD), autism spectrum disorder (ASD), and survivors of Acquired Brain Injury (ABI), Community Connections depends on DSPs to remain with the people supported to ensure optimum participation and enjoyment. 

ABLE ACCOUNT TRAINING: MEFA Director of Attainable Outreach Adam Hartwell, presenter; Wednesday, November 5, 5:30pm. The "Stephen Beck Jr. Achieving a Better Life Experience" Act was signed into law in 2014, establishing what are referred to as ABLE Accounts. These tax-advantaged accounts allow individuals with disabilities and their families to save for short- and long-term qualified disability expenses. Each State administers its version of ABLE within certain guidelines. An ABLE Account in Massachusetts is called an Attainable® Savings Plan, professionally managed by Fidelity Investments. It may be used without affecting other disability-related federal benefits such as Supplemental Security Income (SSI) (for account balances under \$100,000), SNAP, HUD, and others. Earnings in an Attainable® account are federally tax-exempt and qualified distributions are not federally taxed. MEFA serves as the state sponsor. Format: In-Person Watch Party or Virtual.
